6. REVIEW OF PROGRESS.

- The members were glad to note the previous five year admission status and admission status of the session 2023-24. The members were also happy to see the student's achievements, University Results, Merit Positions, Placements and Extra Curricular Activities of our students during the session 2022-23.
- The BOG members were appreciated the faculty achievements and other academic and non-academic events that were being organized in the last one year.

7. B.TECH. CSE AND EE ACCREDITED BY NBA.

The members were glad to see that B.Tech CSE & EE programs have been accredited by NBA and give permission to apply for NBA remaining Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering as per orders of AICTE.

8. UGC AUTONOMOUS STATUS

The Board of Governors were excited to know that College is eligible and in process with the application for autonomous status, demonstrating their commitment to advancing our Educational Quality with autonomy. This decision marks a significant milestone toward a more student-focused and innovative educational. College is preparing for autonomy as per guidelines of National Education Policy 2020.

9. STARTING OF BCA AND BBA PROGRAMS

The Board of Governors has granted permission to start BCA and BBA Programs after attainment of UGC autonomy.

11. ANY OTHER ITEM WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR.

The followings suggestions were came out during the discussion:

- Keeping in the view of the current admission status, where all available seats in the B.Tech CSE program have been filled, the Board of Governors has granted permission to increase intake of B.Tech CSE.
- Due to the sustained trend of lower student admissions in the M.Tech (Manufacturing & Automation) program over the past academic years, it has been proposed to discontinue this program and BOG grant permission to closure M.Tech (M&A) Program.

- Hon'ble Chairman suggested that we should proactively seek out reputed companies for campus placements and students must have passports.
- The Board of Governors has graciously granted permission to commemorate the college's achievements with a series of events, including the Convocation, Alumni Meet, and Silver Jubilee celebration. Dr. S K Sinha proposed the idea of creating and releasing a special souvenir as part of the Silver Jubilee program to commemorate this significant milestone in the college history. All BOG Members are agreeing on this.
- The Hon'ble Chairman suggested that Faculty should visit nearby schools, organize a Principal conclave to enhance outreach efforts and establish partnerships with Schools. It will be helpful to increase admission.
